



ACCELERATED MPP TIMELINE

- Meet with MPP Coordinator for academic advising
- Continue major/minor requirements and MPP prereqs
- Attend MPP information session (spring)

UNDERGRADUATE JUNIOR YEAR

SUMMER BETWEEN JUNIOR & SENIOR YEAR

- **MPP Application Opens (mid-July)**
- Consider a policy-related internship or work experience

- PLCY majors should enroll in PLCY 691H or 698
- Enroll in 1 MPP elective course (optional)

UNDERGRADUATE SENIOR YEAR (FALL)

SEPTEMBER-OCTOBER SENIOR YEAR

- **Application deadline (mid-Sept)**
- Decisions released (mid-Oct)

Enroll in 9-12 credits of MPP coursework (max 12 undergraduate credits may count toward MPP)

UNDERGRADUATE SENIOR YEAR (SPRING)

MAY OF SENIOR YEAR

- **Undergraduate degree awarded**
- Register for Fall semester MPP classes

Complete full-time internship for MPP*

FIRST SUMMER OF MPP

MPP (FALL)

- Full-time MPP coursework
- Professional Development Seminar part 1
- Begin planning for MPP Individual Project

- Full time MPP coursework
- MPP Individual Project
- Professional Development seminar part 2

MPP (SPRING)

JUNE
